Winemaker Alison Doran's notes:

This vineyard is one of the reverential sites in the Napa Valley. With its Volcanic Tuff soils and splendid rolling site carved out of the hills above Rutherford, it produces amazing wines year after year.

The nose floats out as soon as the cork is pulled, with violets, blackberries, and cassis swirling in and out. The palate is still young, focused and energetic, with a strong structure that will reward aging. Black fruit and fine tannin from French oak, are just beginning to integrate into the mid palate. This wine should continue to improve for years to come and to reward the collector.
